Ntokozo Ndlovu is a radiation oncologist and senior lecturer at the University of Zimbabwe, where she coordinates the training for Master of Medicine Degree, Radiotherapy and Oncology. She is Chairperson of the Division of Radiotherapy and Oncology at the Parirenyatwa Group of Hospitals in Harare and is responsible for the administration of the center that serves most of the country. Ms Ndlovu coordinated the rehabilitation of radiotherapy treatment and clinical teaching facilities at the Parirenyatwa Group of Hospitals and at Mpilo Central Hospital in Bulawayo. She also chaired the Strategy Development

Committee during the development of the Zimbabwe National Cancer Prevention and Control Strategy. Ms Ndlovu is also non-executive Board Chairperson of the Radiation Protection Authority of Zimbabwe. She has contributed to several IAEA regional projects and is currently Project Scientific Consultant. Ms Ndlovu was President of the African Radiation Oncology Group. Her research interests are in the area of HIV- related cancers and women cancers.
