The IAEA Ocean Acidification International Coordination Centre (OA-ICC) co-sponsored the largest international gathering on ocean acidification - the 4th International Symposium on the Ocean in a High-CO<sub>2</sub> World, hosted in 2016 by the University of Tasmania Institute for Marine and Antarctic Studies (IMAS), New Zealand and the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organization (CSIRO) in Hobart, Australia. The event, held every four years, discussed key latest developments in ocean acidification science, identified future research needs and trends, and offered prime networking opportunities to hundreds of scientists working on ocean acidification from all over the world.

Thanks to the support of the OA-ICC, 16 scientists from 11 developing IAEA Member States were able to attend the Symposium and present their research. The OA-ICC also provided an exhibition booth showcasing the project's work and resources provided to the ocean acidification community.

## 3rd Global Ocean Acidification Observing Network (GOA-ON) Science Workshop, 8-10 May 2016, Hobart, Australia

The OA-ICC contributed to the <u>3rd GOA-ON Science Workshop</u> that followed the Symposium on the Ocean in a High-CO<sub>2</sub> World. The workshop brought together more than 100 scientists from 40 countries, and discussions tackled several major issues: <u>GOA-ON</u> national and regional status, linkages to other global programmes, data management, developing regional hubs to facilitate national programmes and capacity building etc.

Sponsored by the OA-ICC, six researchers representing several developing IAEA Members States had the opportunity to present their work and interact with GOA-ON members, thus exploring potential future co-operation with the network.

## 4th OA-ICC Advisory Board Meeting

The fourth meeting of the OA-ICC Advisory Board took place on 2 May 2016 in Hobart, Australia, taking advantage of the presence of many of its members on the occasion of the 4th International Symposium on the Ocean in a High- $\mathrm{CO}_2$  World. The Board discussed the project's activities and achievements over the past year, and identified areas for improvement and priorities for the future.
