

Mr Vilmos Cserveny

Senior Advisor to the Resident Representative of Hungary to the IAEA

After graduating from the Budapest University of Economics in 1973, he started working with Hungarian non-governmental organizations deal-ing with foreign policy matters and the Hungarian Ministry of Foreign Affairs dealing with Hungary's relations with the United Nations.

In 1990, Cserveny was appointed Permanent Representative of Hungary to the International Organizations in Vienna and Resident Representa-tive of Hungary to the IAEA. He was later appointed Chairman of the Industrial Development Board of the United Nations Industrial Develop-ment Organization (UNIDO) as well as Chairman of different policy-making organs and committees of the Vienna-based international organiza-tions. He was elected Chairman of the 1992 Review Conference of the Convention of the Physical Protection of Nuclear Materials.

In 1992, he joined the Office of External Relations and Policy Coordination of the IAEA Secretariat, where he assumed several responsibilities in the areas of nuclear safety and security, safeguards, and non-proliferation policies. From 2003 to 2010, he was Head of EXPO, first as Director and later as the Agency's Assistant Director General, and was responsible for all policy-related matters in the IAEA Secretariat. In January 2011, the Director General of the IAEA appointed Cserveny

Head of the Secretariat of the Policy-making Organs of the IAEA, where he served until his retirement in July 2013.

As Senior Advisor to the Hungarian Resident Representative to the IAEA, Cserveny served as Chairman of the Committee of the Whole of the IAEA's 60th General Conference in 2016 and as Chairman of the 2017 Meeting of the Representatives of States Parties to the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material (CPPNM) and the CPPNM Amendment.
