



Grigory Berdennikov, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, Ambassador-at-Large of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, was born in Moscow in 1950.

He graduated from Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO) in 1973. After graduation he worked in the Permanent Mission of the USSR to the UN in New York (1973-1978), MFA Department of International Organizations (1978-1981), Permanent Mission of the USSR to the UN and Other International Organizations in Geneva (1981-1986), MFA Department of Arms Limitation and Disarmament (1986-1992). In 1993-1998 served as a Permanent Representative of the Russian Federation to the Conference on Disarmament in Geneva. In 1998-1999 – Director, Department of Security and Disarmament Affairs, MFA of Russia. In 1992-1993 and 1999-2001 was Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation. In 2001-2007 – Permanent Representative of the Russian Federation to the International Organizations in Vienna. Representative of the Russian Federation in the IAEA Board of Governors since 2003. Ambassador-at-Large in the MFA of Russia since 2007. Mr. G. Berdennikov is married, has one daughter.
