Dr Al-Ibraheem is the Chair of the Department of Nuclear Medicine & PET/CT and Head of the Thyroid Cancer Multidisciplinary Team at King Hussein Cancer Center (KHCC). He got his certifications in nuclear medicine from the European Union of Medical Specialties (FEBNM), the Jordan Medical Council (JBNM), the Asian Nuclear Medicine Board (FANMB) and the American Certification Board of Nuclear Cardiology (CBNC). Dr Al-Ibraheem completed a specialized fellowship in PET/CT and nuclear oncology at the Technische Universität München (TUM) in Germany in 2008 and 2009. Dr Al-Ibraheem is currently the president of

the Arab Society of Nuclear Medicine (ARSNM), the president of the Jordanian Society of Nuclear Medicine (JOSNM) as well as Vice President of the Asia Oceania Federation of Nuclear Medicine and Biology (AOFNMB). He is also an expert consultant to the IAEA. He has introduced state-of-the-art hybrid imaging and nuclear oncology services in Jordan, such as molecular imaging, novel radionuclide therapies to treat neuroendocrine tumours and prostate cancer. Dr Al-Ibraheem has authored and published several articles in international peer-reviewed journals focusing mainly on hybrid imaging and molecular imaging, PET/CT in cancer management and theranostics.
