
IAEA support to Member States on cancer

- Assist to plan and build nuclear medicine and radiotherapy facilities
- Provide education and training for oncologists, radiologists, medical physicists, etc.
- Help governments to put national plans in place to offer comprehensive cancer care, including legislative assistance
- Research projects
- Help ensure that both patients and staff are protected

IAEA's cancer control related activities (1/3) <u>Department of Technical Cooperation</u>

- Regional Divisions
 - Plan, develop and implement cancer-related TC projects
- The Division of the Programme of Action for Cancer Therapy
 - Coordinate imPACT review missions, support Member States to develop NCCPs, raise additional resources for IAEA's cancer-related activities

IAEA's cancer control related activities (2/3) <u>Department of Nuclear Sciences and Applications</u>

- Division of Human Health

 Implement IAEA's cancer-related activities, including coordinating research projects and developing training materials

- Division of Physical and Chemical Sciences

 Provision of technical support for establishment of medical cyclotron facilities, radiopharmaceutical production laboratories and hospital radiopharmacy facilities




IAEA's cancer control related activities (3/3) Department of Nuclear Safety and Security


- Radiation protection and safety of patients and health workers and security of radioactive sources

Coordination of IAEA's Cancer Control-related Activities




