Background
------------

The GSR Part 7 states that "The goal of emergency preparedness is to ensure that an adequate capability is in place within the operating organization and at local, regional and national levels and, where appropriate, at the international level, for an effective response in a nuclear or radiological emergency."

<u>Capacity building</u> is crucial to maintain sustainable infrastructure in EPR. With this in mind, starting from 2013 the IAEA designated 7 IAEA Capacity Building Centres around the world.

A Capacity Building Centre (CBC) is an organization or group of organizations with capabilities to implement education, training or information sharing activities. The objective of the establishment of CBCs is to recognize existing strengths of Member States, build on them to more efficiently and effectively channel and deliver EPR knowledge and best practices, and further enhance the expertise of CBCs towards a sustainable development of capabilities regionally and internationally.

The aim of this webinar is to explain the concept of CBC and to encourage Member States to strengthen national, regional and international capacity to respond to nuclear and radiological emergencies.

- To outline the role of IAEA in establishing the CBC;
