Ms Hussein is the head of the Radiology Department at the Egyptian Atomic Energy Authority and a professor of radiology and a head of the Radiographic Imaging Technology Department. at the Misr University for Science & Technology in Egypt. She is the Chairman of the National Committee for Improving Higher Education and the Vice Chairman of the National Ethics Committee. She also acts as a Director of Radiation Safety at the Egyptian Society of Radiology.

Ms Hussein is an international expert and consultant working for the IAEA in the field of radiology, human health, radiation protection in medicine. She is a member of the Standing Advisory Group of the IAEA Director General on Technical Assistance & Cooperation (SAGTAC), and a regional focal point and expert for the WHO Switzerland & the European Society of Radiology. She is also a member of the International Commission on Radiological Protection (ICRP).

She won four awards for the best research and accomplishments in radiation dose reduction (eg Montreal award 2014). She was also selected as role model African leader “Women In Nuclear “ at the IAEA Scientific Forum in 2018, and a “Woman in Focus” by the European Congress of Radiology in 2019. She is a founding member of Arabsafe, Afrosafe and one of the international working group of the ICRP.
