



Mr Serge Morand

Mr Morand's main achievements are the research development in social-ecology of health - by linking environment, land use changes, climate change, biodiversity and the transmission ecology of zoonotic agents or genes of antimicrobial resistance at the interfaces of human, animal and environmental health.

He has also conducted several interdisciplinary projects in Southeast Asia that have fostered the establishment of an international network of researchers in biodiversity and health. These studies make it possible to identify disciplinary and sectoral boundaries through the development of collaborative social-ecological health projects, co-constructed with local communities, local and national administrations (public health, animal health, agriculture, national parks) and international academics.

The experiences gained from these long-term and extensive studies contributed to the expertise of international organizations such as the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP), and One Health (and One Health High Level Expert Panel (OHHLEP)), WHO-CBD Biodiversity and Health, but also the Knowledge Coordination Body of EKLIPSE (EU).
