Dr Tatul Saghatelyan Saghatelyan is a nationally recognized expert with 20 years of professional experience in radiation oncology in Armenia. He completed his residency in oncology and radiotherapy at the National Institute of Health (NIH) of Armenia in 2002 and has participated in numerous IAEA supported training activities and fellowships early in his career, which helped him to gain extensive knowledge and experience in

radiation oncology and related fields.

Dr Saghatelyan was appointed Head of the Radiation Oncology Department of the National Center of Oncology, which he has led successfully for six years.

Since 2009 he has served as a faculty member at the Oncology Chair, Yerevan State Medical University, and contributed to various national and international scientific events as an invited lecturer/expert and faculty member.

Dr Saghatelyan promotes clinical research in oncology in Armenia as a researcher and as Vice-Chair of the Scientific Council of the National Center of Oncology. He is the National Counterpart for several IAEA Technical Cooperation projects, radiation oncology field expert of Armenia's National Cancer Control Board, co-author of a clinical oncology textbook in Armenian (2018) and has published articles in more than 50 local and international periodicals.
