1969:

In March 1969 the Panel on Instrumentation for Nuclear Power Plant Control pointed out I&C as one of the topics of growing importance for the development of NPPs and the area where international collaboration would be very beneficial

1971:

The Agency established a standing Working Group on Nuclear Power Plant Control and Instrumentation (NPPCI) to facilitate the exchange of views and experience in this field between specialists. The first meeting of the NPPCI was held from **15 to 19 March 1971** in Vienna. (23 participants from 15 Member States and 2 organizations).

- To promote an exchange of information on national programmes, new developments and experience from operating nuclear power plants and to stimulate the co-ordination of research in the field of NPP control and instrumentation.
