Report of the Programme, Technical and Budget Committee

1. The Committee considered item 24 - The use of funds provided to defray the Agency's administrative and operational services costs in 1960 under the United Nations Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance - at its twenty-fifth meeting, held on 23 September 1960.
2. The Committee had before it a report and recommendation by the Board of Governors (GC(IV)/119). After discussion, the Committee approved the draft resolution contained in that document by 38 votes in favor, four against, with nine abstentions.
3. The Committee therefore recommends for adoption by the General Conference the following draft resolution.

Having noted the Board's report on the use of funds provided to defray the Agency's administrative and operational services costs in 1960 under the United Nations Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance<sup>1/</sup>, as well as

the text of resolution 737 (XXVIII) of the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations annexed thereto, relating to the allocation of such costs between "Regular and Expanded Programme budgets",

Approves the Board's recommendation that the funds provided to the Agency for administrative and operational services costs incurred in 1960 be used to increase the Agency's activities under the United Nations Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance.
