THE MATTER OF THE GRANT OF CONSULTATIVE STATUS WITH THE AGENCY TO THE WORLD FEDERATION OF TRADE UNIONS

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling its resolution GC(III)/RES/47 of 2 October 1959,
- (b) Noting that the World Federation of Trade Unions has consultative status with the United Nations, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations and the International Labour Organization, and
- (c) <u>Reiterating</u> that the World Federation of Trade Unions recognizes the objectives and functions of the Agency and declares its support for the practical work of the Agency,

Recommends the Board of Governors, in accordance with Article V.D of the Statute, to reconsider again and decide positively the question of granting consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions.
