VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR 1962

Report of the Committee for Pledges of Voluntary Contributions to the General Fund

Rapporteur: Mr. R. POLACZEK (Austria)

- 1. On 4 October 1961, the Committee for Pledgos of Voluntary Contributions to the General Fund held its third moeting, under the chairmanship of the President of the General Conference, for the purpose of receiving announcements of pledges of voluntary contributions of money to the General Fund for 1962.
- 2. Before the pledges were announced, the Chairman drew the attention of the Committee to the Rules Regarding the Acceptance of Voluntary Contributions of Money to the Agency.
- 3. A list of the sums plodged is given in the table annexed hereto, but it was indicated in some cases that the pleages made were subject to the approval of the legislative authorities of the Governments concerned. The delegates of certain other Member States listed in the Annex hereto announced their Governments' intentions to make contributions to the General Fund for 1962, but were unable to inform the Committee of the exact amount.
- 4. Besides the pledges of voluntary contributions of monoy listed in the Annex hereto, the Committee took note of the offer, made on behalf of the Government of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic, to supply a cobalt-60 unit and to train the personnel necessary to operate the unit. The Committee noted that the total value of the offer was approximately US \$30 000 and that in addition the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic would make available 15 followships.

- 5. After the pledges had been made, one member of the Committee gave notice that his delegation was not satisfied that certain of the pledges were, in fact, pledges to the General Fund within the meaning of the Rules referred to in paragraph 2 above.
- 6. At the conclusion of its meeting, the Committee unanimously decided to recommend to the General Conference the adoption of the following resolution.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR 1962

The General Conference,

Recalling its resolution on the need for increased voluntary contributions to the General Fund,

- 1. Takes note of the report of the Committee for Pledges of Voluntary Contributions to the General Fund;
- 2. Expresses its appreciation to those Member States which have pledged voluntary contributions to the General Fund for 1962, noting that certain of those pledges are subject to legislative decision by the authorities concerned;
- 3. <u>Urges</u> all other Member States to contribute to the General Fund in 1962 to the maximum extent compatible with their resources, in order that the Agency's activities in that year shall not be curtailed through lack of funds; and
- 4. Requests the Director General to inform Member States from time to time of additional pledges notified to him after the end of the fifth regular session.
