The introduction of biennial programming

On 20 June 1963 the Board of Governors decided to recommend the following draft resolution for adoption by the General Conference.

INTRODUCTION OF BIENNIAL PROGRAMMING

The General Conference,

(a) <u>Recalling</u> its Resolution GC(VI)/RES/120 regarding biennial programming within the framework of annual budgets.

(b) <u>Bearing in mind</u> the invitation it has addressed to the Board of Governors and the Director General to take the long-term programme for the Agency's activities [1] as a guide in planning and executing the Agency's work over the years beginning in 1965 [2],

(c) <u>Considering that 1965 will also be the first year of the next biennial period</u> under the United Nations Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance,

Invites the Board of Governors and the Director General to take steps to implement the proposal for biennial programming within the framework of annual budgets, beginning in 1965.
