> CREDENTIALS OF DELEGATES TO THE SEVENTH REGULAR SESSION (b) REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE <u>Chairman</u>; Mr. A.D. McKNIGHT (Australia)

1. At its 73rd plenary meeting on 24 September 1963 the General Conference appointed a Credentials Committee consisting of the following members:

> Afghanistan Argentina Australia Czechoslovak Socialist Republic France

Philippines Union of Soviet Socialist Republics United States of América Venezuela

2. The Credentials Committee met on Tuesday, 1 October 1963.

3. Mr. A.D. McKnight (Australia) was unanimously cleeted Chairman of the Committee.

4. The delegate of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics stated that "his delegation did not recognize as valid any credentials issued by the Chiang-kai-shek regime which, in reality, did not represent anybody".

5. The delegate of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic associated himself with the foregoing rémarks of the representative of the Soviet Union.

6. The delegate of the United States of America proposed that the Committee should recommend to the General Conference the adoption of the draft resolution which is reproduced as draft resolution I at the end of this report. He added that the issue of China's representation had been GC(VII)/264 page 2

debated in the General Assembly of the United Nations in 1961, and 1962 where proposals for a change had been rejected. He declared that it was desirable that the General Conference, by adopting this draft, follow the precedent set by the General Assembly of the United Nations and by other international organizations.

7. The United States motion was accepted.

8. The Committee found that credentials satisfying the provisions of Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference had been submitted to the Director General of the Agency for the delegates of the following Member States

9. The Committee found that the credentials submitted for the delegates of the following Member States did not satisfy the provisions of Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference:

10. The Committee further found that Ecuador was represented by an observer and that no credentials had been received in respect of the delegate from Uruguay.

12. The Committee decided to ask the Director General to request the Member States which had not already done so to submit credentials which would satisfy the provisions of Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure. The Committee proposed that, pending the submission of such credentials, the representatives concerned should be seated provisionally with the same rights as other representatives.

13. The Committee submits to the General Conference the following two draft resolutions:

## The General Conference,

(a) <u>Recalling</u> the recommendation of the fifth regular session of the General Assembly of the United Nations on 14 December 1950 that "the attitude adopted by the General Asscmbly" regarding the representation of a Member State "should be taken into account in other organs of the" United Nations and in the specialized agencies", and (b) <u>Recalling</u> the action which the sixtcenth and seventeenth regular sessions of the General Assembly took on 15 December 1961 and
30 October 1962 regarding the representation of China,

1. <u>Decides</u> to take no action on any proposal to change the representation of China at its seventh regular session; and

2. <u>Finds</u> that the credentials of the delegate of the Government of China conform with the provisions of Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure.
