APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Applications by Jordan and Jamaica

Recommendations by the Board of Governors

1. On 26 July and 8 September respectively the following communications received by the Director General, the first from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Jordan and the second from the Acting Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs of Jamaica, were communicated to the Board of Governors:

Telegram from Jordan

"3070

"17 JULY

"I HAVE THE HONOUR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY IN THE NAME OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JORDAN [stop] I WISH TO ASSURE YOU IN THE NAME OF MY GOVERNMENT THAT JORDAN IS WILLING TO CARRY OUT THE OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY AND TO ACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PURPOSES AND PRINCIPLES OF THE CHARTER OF THE UNITED NATIONS"

Communication from Jamaica

"In the name of the Government of Jamaica I have the honour to submit an application for membership of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

"I wish to assure you, in the name of my Government, that Jamaica is willing to carry out the obligations of membership of the Agency and to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations.

"19 August 1965."

2. On 17 September the Board considered these two applications for membership of the Agency in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute, and determined that Jordan and Jamaica were willing and able to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve the two States for membership of the Agency, and submits the two draft resolutions below for the consideration of the Conference.

Draft resolution A

APPLICATION BY JORDAN FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

- (a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Jordan should be approved for membership of the Agency,^{*} and
- (b) Having considered Jordan's application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

Approves Jordan for membership of the Agency.

Draft resolution B

APPLICATION BY JAMAICA FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference

- (a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Jamaica should be approved for membership of the Agency,^{*} and
- (b) Having considered Jamaica's application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

Approves Jamaica for membership of the Agency.
