APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Application by Uganda

Recommendation by the Board of Governors

1. On 15 November 1965 the following letter addressed to the Director General by the acting Minister of State for Foreign Affairs of Uganda was communicated to the Board:

"In the name of the Government of Uganda I have the honour to submit an application for membership of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

"I wish to assure you, in the name of my Government, that Uganda is willing to carry out the obligations of membership of the Agency and to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations."

2. On 24 February 1966 the Board considered this application for membership of the Agency in the light of Article IV. B of the Statute, and determined that Uganda was able and willing to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve Uganda for membership of the Agency, and submits the draft resolution below for the consideration of the Conference.

APPLICATION BY UGANDA FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

(a) <u>Having received</u> the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Uganda should be approved for membership of the Agency, [*] and

(b) <u>Having considered</u> Uganda's application for membership in the light of Article IV. B of the Statute,

Approves Uganda for membership of the Agency.
