APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Application by Singapore

Recommendation by the Board of Governors

1. On 11 August 1966 the following application for the admission of the Republic of Singapore to membership of the Agency, signed by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic, was communicated to the Board:

"25 July 1966

"APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY

"In the name of the Government of the Republic of Singapore I have the honour to submit an application for membership of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

"I wish to assure you, in the name of my Government, that the Republic of Singapore is willing to carry out the obligations of membership of the Agency and to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations."

2. On 19 September the Board considered this application for membership of the Agency in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute, and determined that Singapore was able and willing to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve Singapore for membership of the Agency, and submits the draft resolution below for the consideration of the Conference.

APPLICATION BY SINGAPORE FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

(a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Singapore should be approved for membership of the Agency^{*/}, and

(b) Having considered Singapore's application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

Approves Singapore for membership of the Agency.
