Burma

"7 September 1967

"It is suggested that IAEA should provide equipment and supplies to developing countries which have local personnel trained in atomic energy techniques. The provision of a foreign expert or experts should not be insisted upon by IAEA if the Member State requesting the equipment and supplies already has trained local personnel.

"Organization of more frequent short-term advanced courses in the Region in different aspects of the peaceful uses of atomic energy is also deemed necessary.

"When equipment is supplied, the vital spare parts should also be included. Scientific journals should be distributed to Member States."
