2. When the Conference takes up this item of its agenda the President will invite its attention to the contributions to the General Fund for next year that have by then been pledged. In order to expedite matters, the delegates of those Members that have not yet pledged a contribution are invited to communicate their Government's pledges as soon as possible to the officer who sits during plenary meetings at a table marked "Voluntary Contributions", near the foot of the podium in the Festsaal, and who will be at a table similarly identified in the Zeremoniensaal at other times.
