The delegates of Members that have not yet made a pledge are accordingly invited to communicate their Governments' pledges as soon as possible to the officer who will be sitting during plenary meetings at a table marked "Voluntary Contributions" near the foot of the podium in the Festsaal, and who will be at a table similarly identified in the Zeremoniensaal at other times.
