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ASSESSMENT OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARDS THE AGENCY'S ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

Scale of assessment for 1972

Memorandum by the Director General

1. The Director General herewith submits to the General Conference a draft of a resolution whereby it could set the scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for 1972. The draft scale has been prepared on the assumption that the Conference will be agreeable to supplementing the principles for assessing Members for such contributions which it approved in 1959 [1] with the further principles that are the subject of document GC(XV)/462. It will be noted in this connection that the draft resolution also provides for the Conference to approve the base rate of assessment which the Director General has initially determined for each Member.

2. The series of computations that were required in order to establish a scale of assessment on this basis are reproduced in the Annex hereto, in which references are given to the various supplementary principles set forth in the draft resolution in document GC(XV)/462 that provide authority for the calculations made.

3. In regard to the determination of the base rate of assessment [2], it will be seen that it is derived from the scale used by the United Nations to assess contributions from its Members to its regular budget for 1971, adjustments being made to compensate for differences in membership between the Agency and the United Nations.

At present 102 States are Members of the Agency, [3] one less than when the Conference met last year, as Nicaragua has since withdrawn from membership.

4. Pursuant to the supplementary principle set forth in sub-paragraph (c)(ii) of the draft resolution (GC(XV)/462), the Director General has drawn up a list of the Members meeting the criteria laid down therein, in collaboration with the Controller of the United Nations. The list has been communicated to Members to enable any Member on it that so desired to notify the Director General of its wish not to be included. No Member has done so. The use to which the list, which comprises 71 Members, has been put is shown in paragraph 4 of the Annex.

THE ELABORATION OF THE SCALE OF ASSESSMENT OF MEMBERS'
CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE REGULAR BUDGET FOR 1972Computations by the Director General

1. The first step in the computations required to enable the scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for the year 1972 to be elaborated consists of the division of the total sum to be assessed into a non-safeguards component and a safeguards component. [1] The total assessment proposed is \$15 392 000 [2], of which the non-safeguards and safeguards components are \$12 949 000 and \$2 443 000 respectively.

2. The next step is to derive a base rate of assessment for each Member of the Agency from the scale used by the United Nations to assess contributions from its Members to its regular budget for 1971. [3] This is done in Table 1 below, the calculation of the coefficient 0.909189 used in column (4) thereof being set out in paragraph 3 below.

3. It will be seen from the Table that the United Nations percentage assessments for the 95 Members of the Agency that are also Members of the United Nations amount to 98.76, and that the United Nations hypothetical percentage assessments for the remaining seven Members amount to 7.94. To this total of 106.70 a coefficient must be applied in deriving the full set of the base rates of assessment for each Member of the Agency, so as to reduce the total to 100.00%. However, in accordance with a principle established by the General Conference no coefficient is applied in the case of the Member bearing the United Nations highest assessment of 31.52% nor of the 35 Members each bearing the lowest assessment of 0.04%. [4] The coefficient is therefore calculated in the following way:

5. It will be noted that for each Member listed in the foregoing Table the alternative share in column (3) is less than the minimum permissible share in column (6). In every case, therefore, the figures in columns (6) and (7) are the same - that is, the required share is always the minimum permissible share.

6. From Table 2 it will also be seen that 71 Members will be required to contribute \$314 799 (12.88576%) of the total safeguards component of \$2 443 000 [7]. The remaining \$2 128 201 (87.11424%) will need to be borne by the other 31 Members, the share of each being calculated as shown in the following Table [8].

7. The individual shares of each Member in the safeguards component of the total assessment having thus been determined, the next step is to calculate each Member's share of the non-safeguards component. This is done in the final Table below, [9] which shows in column (5) the consequent total assessment of each Member. Column (6) gives the resulting scale of assessment for 1972, the percentage assessments being expressed to five places of decimals in order to reflect accurately each Member's share of the safeguards component.
