THE AGENCY'S RELATIONS WITH INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS Resolution adopted during the 158th plenary meeting on 3 October 1972

REPRESENTATION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS AT REGULAR SESSIONS OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE

The General Conference,

(a) <u>Considering</u> it to be in the Agency's interest to provide, as it has in the past, for the representation at the Conference's regular sessions of certain categories of intergovernmental organizations $\frac{1}{2}$,

(b) <u>Taking into account</u> the fact that not all the organizations in question have co-operation agreements with the Agency entitling them to be so represented,

<u>Requests</u> the Board of Governors to invite those intergovernmental organizations that do not have co-operation agreements with the Agency but are concerned with developing uses of nuclear energy for peaceful purposes or with research in the nuclear sciences, which it may from year to year decide it would be in the Agency's interest to invite, to be represented by observers at regular sessions of the General Conference.
