VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR 1974

Memorandum by the Director General

 The table overleaf is intended to notify delegates, at the opening of the General Conference's session, of the pledges of voluntary contributions to the General Fund for 1974 that Members of the Agency have made by noon on
18 September 1973.

2. It is foreseen that the Conference will consider the matter of voluntary contributions to the General Fund in a plenary meeting at which the President will invite attention to the list of contributions pledged in advance, and revisions of the present memorandum will be issued as the session proceeds for the purpose of keeping the Conference informed of the growth in the total value of the pledges that Members have made.

3. The delegates of Members that have not yet made a pledge are accordingly invited to communicate their Governments' pledges as soon as possible to the officer who will be sitting during plenary meetings at a table marked "Voluntary Contributions" near the foot of the podium in the Festsaal, and who at other times will be at a table similarly identified in the Zeremoniensaal.
