APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Resolution adopted during the 168th plenary meeting on 16 September 1974

APPLICATION BY MAURITIUS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

(a) <u>Having received</u> the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Mauritius should be approved for membership of the Agency $\frac{1}{}$, and

(b) <u>Having considered</u> the application of Mauritius for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

1. Approves Mauritius for membership of the Agency; and

2. <u>Determines</u>, pursuant to Financial Regulation $6.08^{2/}$, that in the event of Mauritius becoming a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1974 or in 1975, it shall be assessed as appropriate:

- (a) For an advance or advances to the Working Capital Fund, in accordance with Financial Regulation $7.03^{3/2}$; and
- (b) For a contribution or contributions towards the Agency's administrative expenses, in accordance with the principles for the assessment of Members for such contributions⁴.
