Arrangements for the next session

Note by the Director General

1. On 22 September 1975 the Director General received a letter from the Delegate of Brazil to the nineteenth regular session of the General Conference which reads as follows:

"20 September 1975

"I have the honour to inform you that the Brazilian Government takes pleasure in inviting the General Conference of the International Atomic Energy Agency to hold its twentieth regular session, in 1976, in my country.

"My Government wishes by this invitation to commemorate the twentieth anniversary of the creation of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

"Under the terms of an agreement to be signed in due course, as was previously done when the General Conference met in Japan and in Mexico, my Government is prepared to provide all the necessary facilities and the local staff required, and likewise to defray such additional expenditure as the Agency may incur in holding the session away from its headquarters.

"My Government will also have the honour to extend to delegations from Member States, observers and Secretariat staff the same facilities as those which they enjoy at the sessions held at the Agency's head-quarters."

2. Should the Conference decide to accept the foregoing invitation, the Director General does not foresee that such a decision would give rise to any administrative difficulties for the Secretariat.
