A COMMUNICATION FROM THE ALTERNATE TO THE DELEGATE OF THE
UNITED REPUBLIC OF CAMEROON

Note by the President

In response to the request made by the alternate to the delegate of the United Republic of Cameroon in the second paragraph of a letter which he addressed to the President on 26 September and which is reproduced below, the text of the declaration transmitted with that letter is set forth overleaf.

On behalf of the following States: Algeria, Cuba, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Jamaica, Kuwait, Libyan Arab Republic, Niger, Nigeria, Philippines, Republic of South Viet-Nam, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Thailand, Tunisia, United Republic of Cameroon, United Republic of Tanzania, Yugoslavia, Zaire and Zambia, I have the honour to transmit to you herewith the text of a declaration concerning the designation of South Africa for membership on the Board of Governors.

"Furthermore, I have the honour to request you to bring the said declaration to the attention of all the States Members of the Agency by means of an information document."

The above States,

- (a) Considering that the Government of South Africa has repeatedly and flagrantly violated the provisions of the United Nations Charter and of the resolutions of the General Assembly and the Security Council, as stated in document A/9780 of 30 September 1974,
 - (b) Considering that, since its twenty-fifth session, the General Assembly has regularly rejected the credentials of the representatives of South Africa,
 - (c) Considering that, at its twenty-ninth session, the General Assembly decided to suspend South Africa from participation in its work,
 - (d) Noting the contradiction between these actions of the General Assembly and the action of the Board of Governors in designating South Africa as a member of the Board for the area of Africa, and
 - (e) Considering that other African countries satisfy the criteria specified in Article VI.A.1 of the Agency's Statute;
1. Protest against the designation of South Africa for membership of the Board of Governors and, while recognizing that the decision taken by the Board should remain valid in respect of the current year, request that such a decision should not be repeated in future;
 2. Invite the Board of Governors to comply with the provisions of Article III.B.1 of the Statute in designating its members; and
 3. Invite all delegations to reconsider the criteria for the representation of different geographical areas on the Board of Governors, bearing in mind particularly the above-mentioned resolutions of the General Assembly of the United Nations.
