ASSESSMENT OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARDS THE AGENCY'S REGULAR BUDGET

Scale of assessment of Members' contributions for 1977

Memorandum by the Director General

1. The Director General submits herewith to the General Conference a draft of a resolution whereby the Conference could set the scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for 1977. The scale annexed to the resolution has been prepared in accordance with the principles established by the Conference in 1959[1] and on the assumption that the Conference will approve the revised set of supplementary principles for the assessment of Members' contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budget, which are the subject of document GC(XX)/569. The scale is based on membership as of 30 June 1976, which includes three States, Qatar, the United Arab Emirates and the United Republic of Tanzania, that became Members during 1976.
2. It will be noted that the resolution would also provide for approval by the General Conference of the base rate of assessment for each Member. This has been derived from the scale used by the United Nations to assess contributions from its Members to its regular budget for 1976, adjusted to compensate for differences in membership between the Agency and the United Nations.
3. The computations that had to be made in order to establish both the individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment are reproduced for the information of the Conference in the Appendix hereto.
4. In accordance with sub-paragraph 3(b) of the draft resolution set forth in document GC(XX)/569, the Director General has drawn up a list of the Members meeting the criteria laid down therein. The list, which comprises 73 Members, is set forth in paragraph 4 of the Appendix.

Draft resolution

SCALE OF ASSESSMENT OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 1977

The General Conference,

Applying the principles it has established for the assessment of Members' contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budget [*],

1. Decides that the individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for 1977 shall be as set forth in the Annex hereto; and
2. Determines, pursuant to Financial Regulation 6.08 [**], that in the event of a State becoming a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1976 or in 1977, it shall be assessed as appropriate:
 - (a) For an advance or advances to the Working Capital Fund, in accordance with Financial Regulation 7.03 [***]; and
 - (b) For a contribution or contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budget, in accordance with the principles the Conference has established for that purpose.

APPENDIX

MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE AGENCY'S REGULAR BUDGET FOR 1977

The computation of individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment

1. The first step in computing the individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for the year 1977 consists in dividing the total amount to be assessed into a "non-safeguards" component and a "safeguards" component[1]. The total assessment proposed is \$37 000 000[2], of which the non-safeguards and safeguards components are \$29 064 000 and \$7 936 000 respectively. The latter component consists of the appropriation specifically proposed for safeguards (\$7 951 000) less income of \$15 000 which it is estimated will be received from non-member States during 1977.

2. The next step is to derive a base rate of assessment for each Member of the Agency[3] from the scale used by the United Nations to assess contributions from its Members to its budgets for the years 1974-1976[4]. In line with the instructions that the General Assembly of the United Nations gave to its Committee on Contributions in 1972[5], this requires in the first place the determination of the base rate of the largest contributor to the Agency's Regular Budget, the United States of America, by reducing its base rate for 1976 (27.57%) by the total of the rates of assessment set by the United Nations for the three States, Qatar, United Arab Emirates and the United Republic of Tanzania (0.02% in each case) that became Members of the Agency during the past year. The resultant base rate for the United States is 27.51%. It is now necessary to compute a coefficient to be applied, in accordance with the principle in Resolution GC(III)/RES/50, to the United Nations percentage assessments for States that are Members of the Agency in order to establish the base rates for 1977. The computation of the coefficient used to calculate the base rates as set forth in column 4 of Table 1 below is explained in paragraph 3. The United Nations in November 1975 reduced the base rate for Bangladesh from 0.10% to 0.08%. Through application of the coefficient, this reduction is offset by Poland's base rate of 1.30% in 1976 being increased to 1.31% and Spain's base rate of 1.02% for 1976 being increased to 1.03%. Accordingly, it will be seen, by comparing Table 1 with the corresponding table for 1976, that the base rate for all Member States remains the same as last year except for the United States of America, Bangladesh, Poland and Spain which change for the reasons indicated above.

3. It will be seen from the end of the foregoing table that the United Nations percentage assessments for Members of the Agency that are also Members of the United Nations amount to 93.92% and that the United Nations rates of assessment for the other Members of the Agency amount to 1.12%. To the figure of 95.04%, obtained by combining these two percentages, a coefficient is applied to establish such base rates of assessment for all Members of the Agency as will give a total of 100.00%. In accordance with a principle established by the General Conference, however, the coefficient is not applied in the case of the Member bearing the United Nations highest assessment, nor of the 40 Members each bearing the United Nations lowest assessment[6]. The coefficient is therefore calculated as follows:

4. It is now necessary to determine the respective shares of the safeguards expenses to be borne by the Members on a list drawn up for the purpose by the Director General[7]. The results are presented in Table 2 below.[8] It will be noted that the amount of safeguards expenses borne by each Member on the list, except the United Republic of Tanzania, is the same as the corresponding amount as assessed in 1976. The United Republic of Tanzania became a Member during 1976 and therefore is included in the list for the first time.

5. It will be noted from the foregoing table that a total of 73 Members will be required to contribute \$353 990 (4.46056%) of the total safeguards component of \$7 936 000[9]. The remaining \$7 582 010 (95.53944%) will need to be borne by 36 Members, the shares of each being calculated as shown in the following table[10].

6. The individual share of each Member in the safeguards component of the total assessment having thus been determined, the next step is to calculate each Member's share of the non-safeguards component. This is done by applying each Member State's base rate of assessment to the non-safeguards component of \$29 064 000[11]. The results are presented in Table 4 below which shows in column (5) the total assessment of each Member. Column (6) gives the resulting scale of assessment for 1977, the percentage assessments being expressed to five places of decimals in order to reflect each Member's share of the Regular Budget to the required accuracy.
