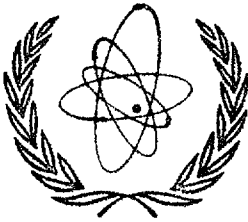

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR 1977

Memorandum by the Director General

1. The table overleaf is intended to notify delegates, at the opening of the General Conference's session, of the pledges of voluntary contributions to the General Fund for 1977 that Members of the Agency had made by 4 p.m. on 20 September 1976.
2. It is foreseen that the Conference will consider the matter of voluntary contributions to the General Fund in a plenary meeting at which the President will invite attention to the list of contributions pledged in advance, and revisions of the present memorandum will be issued as the session proceeds for the purpose of keeping the Conference informed of the growth in the total value of the pledges that Members have made.
3. The delegates of Members that have not yet made a pledge are accordingly invited to communicate their Governments' pledges as soon as possible to the officer who will be sitting during the plenary meetings at a table marked "Voluntary contributions" and who will at other times be in an office in the Conference Centre.

Pledges expressed in US dollars at the rate of exchange used for the United Nations Development Programme. One asterisk indicates that the pledge is less than the Member's base rate of assessment (see document GC (XX)/570, column (2) in the draft resolution), applied to the target of \$6 million for voluntary contributions (see document GC (XX)/567, Annex VII, draft resolution B, paragraph 1) two asterisks indicate that the pledge is more than the Member's base rate of assessment.
