"WITH PLEASURE I SEIZE THE OPPORTUNITY OF THE TWENTY-FIRST SESSION OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY TO CONGRATULATE YOU ON THE OCCASION OF THE TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE AGENCY'S EXISTENCE.

"THE AGENCY HAS PLAYED AN EVER INCREASING ROLE, IN PARTICULAR UNDER YOUR LEADERSHIP THESE LAST YEARS, IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PEACEFUL USES OF ATOMIC ENERGY AND THE NON-PROLIFERATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS.

"THE EXCELLENT RELATIONS WHICH HAVE DEVELOPED OVER THE YEARS BETWEEN THE AGENCY AND THE EUROPEAN ATOMIC ENERGY COMMUNITY HAVE RESULTED IN A CO-OPERATION AGREEMENT AND THE SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT WHICH ENTERED INTO FORCE AT THE BEGINNING OF THIS YEAR.

"I AM CONVINCED THAT OUR FRUITFUL COLLABORATION WILL CONTINUE AND BE INTENSIFIED OVER THE YEARS TO COME."

Message addressed to the President of the twenty-first regular session of the General Conference by the Observer of the Palestine Liberation Organization

"29 September 1977

"On behalf of the Palestine Liberation Organization, the sole representative of the Palestinian people, I extend my warm congratulations for the 20th anniversary of the founding of IAEA. The Agency deserves great praise for its outstanding achievements during such short life-time. This is mainly due to the excellent leadership of Dr. Sigvard Eklund. At the same time I warmly congratulate you, Dr. Etemad, upon your unanimous election as president of the 21st General Conference of IAEA.

"I feel privileged to be part of this General Conference and I convey to you, Mr. President, that we are looking forward to have a positive role in peace and prosperity of mankind. We deplore the proliferation of nuclear weapons and at the same time we applied the peaceful uses of atomic energy."

"IN MY CAPACITY AS CHAIRMAN OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON ENERGY, NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION AND FEDERAL SERVICES, I WISH TO CONVEY TO YOU AND THE IAEA OUR SINCERE CONGRATULATIONS ON THE AGENCY'S TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY. THE SUBCOMMITTEE RECOGNIZES AND APPLAUDS THE COMMENDABLE MANNER IN WHICH THE AGENCY HAS CARRIED OUT ITS TWIN OBJECTIVES. THROUGH ITS VARIED PROGRAMS OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE, THE IAEA HAS SUCCESSFULLY PROMOTED THE PEACEFUL APPLI-CATIONS OF NUCLEAR ENERGY WORLDWIDE. AT THE SAME TIME, IT HAS CREATED, IMPLEMENTED, AND CONTINUOUSLY IMPORVED A SYSTEM OF INTERNATIONAL SAFEGUARDS, WHOSE GOAL IS TO ASSURE AGAINST THE IMPROPER USE OF ASSISTANCE PROVIDED IN THE NUCLEAR FIELD. THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON ENERGY, NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION AND FEDERAL SERVICES, ALONG WITH OTHER SENATE COMMITTEES AND SUBCOMMITTEES, HAS STRONGLY SUPPORTED MEASURES BY THE UNITED STATES TO PROVIDE POLITICAL, FINANCIAL AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT IN FURTHERANCE OF THE AGENCY AND ITS IMPORTANT MISSIONS. ON THE OCCASION OF THE IAEA'S TWENTY-FIRST GENERAL CONFERENCE, YOU MAY BE SURE OF OUR CONTINUED SUPPORT OF ACTIVITIES TO INCREASE THE BENEFITS OF PEACEFUL NUCLEAR APPLICATIONS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD."

Telegram addressed to the Director General on behalf of the Executive of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization
