CONTRIBUTION BY THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN SUPPORT OF THE AGENCY'S PROGRAMME FOR RESEARCH AND MEDICAL THERAPY

Note by the Director General

The Governor from the United States of America on the Board of Governors informed the Director General, in a letter dated 20 September 1978, of a contribution of nuclear material his Government intends to make in 1979 in support of the Agency's programme for research and medical therapy. At the request of the Governor, the text of his letter is reproduced below for the information of the Conference.

"September 20, 1978

"I am pleased to inform you that the United States Government is prepared to donate in 1979, for the 20th consecutive year, up to \$50 000 worth of special nuclear material to sustain the IAEA program for research and medical therapy. In allocating this gift material, parties to the Non-Proliferation Treaty will be given preference, as we have indicated in prior years."
