## THE FINANCING OF SAFEGUARDS

### Note by the Director General

1. The Board of Governors has this year reviewed the arrangements for the financing of safeguards pursuant to a resolution adopted by the General Conference in 1983<sup>1/</sup> and has requested the Director General to transmit to the General Conference the text of a draft resolution in respect of arrangements for the assessment of Member's contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budgets for the years 1985 and 1986.
2. The draft resolution is accordingly presented below.

### Draft resolution

#### ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARDS THE AGENCY'S REGULAR BUDGET

#### The General Conference

- (a) Recalling its resolutions embodying principles for the assessment of Members' contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budget<sup>2/</sup>, in particular paragraph 4 of resolution GC(XXVII)/RES/416, and
- (b) Having considered the Board's recommendation to continue with the current arrangements for a further two years,

1. Decides that the arrangements for the assessment of Members' contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budget which it approved by resolution GC(XXVII)/RES/416 to supplement those contained in resolution GC(III)/RES/50 and GC(XXI)/RES/351 shall continue to be applicable for the years 1985 and 1986; and
2. Further decides that the Board shall review these arrangements, initiating appropriate consultations immediately after the end of the twenty-eighth regular session of the General Conference, and make a recommendation thereon to the General Conference at its twenty-ninth regular session.
