REPRESENTATION OF IAEA MEMBER STATES NOT MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AT MEETINGS OF THE BOARD AS OBSERVERS

Draft resolution submitted by the Philippines*/

The General Conference,

- (a) <u>Recalling</u> that the principle of the sovereign equality of all Member States of the Agency is deeply enshrined in its Statute,
- (b) <u>Stressing</u> that the principle of universality is observed in the United Nations specialized agencies and other international bodies, and
- (c) <u>Believing</u> that the representation of Member States not members of the Board at the meetings of the Board is a right which should be accorded to them in implementation of the above principles,
- 1. <u>Urges</u> the Board to invite Member States of the IAEA not members of the Board, as a matter of course and within the meaning of Rule 50 of the Board's Provisional Rules of Procedure, to participate, without the right to vote, in the deliberations of the Board; and
- 2. <u>Requests</u> the Board to submit a report hereon to the General Conference at its next (1990) regular session.
