The General Conference,

<u>Convinced</u> that Agency safeguards can promote further confidence among States and thereby help to strengthen their collective security,

- 1. <u>Underlines</u> the importance of effective safeguards for the prevention of misuse of nuclear technology for non-peaceful purposes; and
- 2. Requests the Board of Governors and the Director General to continue their efforts to develop effective measures to strengthen the effectiveness and efficiency of the safeguards system in conformity with the Statute without diminishing the resources devoted to promotional activities.
