The General Conference,

(a) <u>Recalling</u> its resolution GC(39)/RES/13,

(b) <u>Welcoming</u> the fact that the requirements for the entry into force of the Convention on Nuclear Safety were met on 26 July 1996 by the deposit of the twenty-fifth instrument of ratification, acceptance or approval, it being also the seventeenth instrument from a State having at least one nuclear installation which has achieved criticality in a reactor core, so that the Convention will enter into force on 24 October 1996, and

(c) <u>Recognizing</u> that decisions on implementation of the Convention are the responsibility of the States Parties,

1. <u>Appeals</u> to all Member States which have not yet done so to become Parties to the Convention so that it will obtain the widest possible adherence;

2. <u>Expresses</u> its satisfaction that the Director General, in his capacity as the Depositary of the Convention, will convene a preparatory meeting of Contracting Parties at the Agency's Headquarters at a date to be agreed upon but not later than April 1997; and

3. <u>Requests</u> the Secretariat to provide support to the Contracting Parties and to the signatory States in preparing for implementation of the Convention.
