# MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION IN NUCLEAR, RADIATION AND WASTE SAFETY

## THE JOINT CONVENTION ON THE SAFETY OF SPENT FUEL MANAGEMENT AND ON THE SAFETY OF RADIOACTIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT

#### Draft resolution recommended by the Committee of the Whole

### The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling resolution GC(40)/RES/11,
- (b) Expressing its appreciation to the Open-ended Group of Legal and Technical Experts for the completion of its task,
- (c) <u>Expressing</u> its gratitude to the Secretariat for the support it gave in the preparation of the Convention,
- (d) Stressing the important role of the Agency in acting as a driving force in nuclear safety through its various safety programmes and initiatives, and
- (e) <u>Recognizing</u> that decisions on implementation of the Convention are the responsibility of States Parties,
- 1. <u>Welcomes</u> the adoption of the Joint Convention on the Safety of Spent Fuel Management and on the Safety of Radioactive Waste Management in Vienna on 5 September 1997;
- 2. <u>Appeals</u> to all States to sign and subsequently ratify, accept or approve the Convention, so that it may enter into force as soon as possible;

- 3. Expresses the hope that the Convention will obtain the widest possible adherence; and
- 4. <u>Requests</u> the Secretariat to give its support to signatory and other interested States in preparing for implementation of the Convention.
