International Conference on National Infrastructures for Radiation Safety: Towards Effective And Sustainable Systems

Report by the Director General

- 1. The International Conference on National Infrastructures for Radiation Safety: Towards Effective and Sustainable Systems took place in Rabat, Morocco, from 1 to 5 September 2003 under the patronage of His Majesty Mohammed VI. The Conference was hosted by the Government of Morocco (through the Université Mohammed V, Agdal) and organized by the Agency in co-operation with the World Health Organization, the International Labour Organization, the European Commission and the Nuclear Energy Agency of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development.
- 2. The Conference, presided over by Mr. H. Boutaleb, President of the Université Mohammed V, Agdal, was attended by over 350 participants from 109 countries (including nine non-Member States) and seven organizations.
