### Amendment to Article XIV.A of the Statute

Report by the Director General

- 1. On 1 October 1999, by resolution GC(43)/RES/8 the General Conference, at its 43<sup>rd</sup> regular session, approved an amendment to Article XIV.A of the Agency's Statute. The Secretariat submitted document GC(48)/INF/8 to the General Conference at its 48<sup>th</sup> regular session to inform Member States of progress in acceptance by Member States of the amendment and to reiterate the benefits of biennial budgeting.
- 2. In this connection the Agency's External Auditor has recommended in his report on the audit of the Agency's accounts for 2004 that "efforts be made by Member States to complete the ratification process" for acceptance of the amendment (paragraph 109 of document GC(49)/7 refers).
- 3. The purpose of this document is to provide an updated report to Member States on the progress made.

### **Progress Made towards Entry Into Force**

- 4. On 5 September 2005, the Director General sent a circular note verbale to the Ministers for Foreign Affairs of Member States that referred to the circular notes verbales dated 3 November 1999, 10 November 2000 and 26 September 2002 on the issue of amendment to Article XIV.A of the Statute. It was indicated in the note of 5 September 2005 that "[t]he Director General wishes to emphasize that the introduction of biennial budgeting would facilitate better planning and increased flexibility in programme implementation and would thus enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of programme delivery, as described in detail in document GC(48)/INF/8."
- 5. While, in accordance with Article XVIII.C(ii) of the Statute, two-thirds of all the Members of the Agency will have to accept the amendment in order for it to enter into force, as of this date only 38 Member States have deposited instruments of acceptance with the depositary Government (the United States of America).

6. Attached to this document as Annex I is a list of those States whose acceptance of this amendment has been notified by the depositary Government to the Agency as of the date of this document.
