Text of Communication dated 13 July 2006 received from the Resident Representative of Georgia to the Agency Concerning Restoration of Voting Rights

The text of a letter dated 13 July 2006 from the Resident Representative of Georgia addressed to the Director General is reproduced herewith for the attention of the General Conference.

I would like to inform you that despite the serious financial difficulties faced by the Government of Georgia over a number of years, the Government remains committed to fulfilling its financial obligations to the IAEA, and in this regard, made a payment of over 60 000 EURO to the IAEA in April this year.

The Government of Georgia has officially requested the conclusion of a ten year Payment Plan Agreement, starting in 2007, to pay off its arrears to the regular budget, as well as a three year Payment Plan Agreement to settle its assessed programme costs arrears.

On the basis of these commitments and the recent payment, the Government of Georgia requests the restoration of its voting rights at the General Conference in September this year.
