# Amendment to Article VI of the Statute

Report by the Director General

- 1. On 1 October 1999, in resolution GC(43)/RES/19 the General Conference, at its 43<sup>rd</sup> regular session, approved an amendment to Article VI of the Agency's Statute and urged all Member States of the Agency to accept this amendment as soon as possible. Further to the Conference's request in the same resolution, the Secretariat submitted a report in document GC(45)/INF/7 to the 45<sup>th</sup> regular session of the General Conference on the progress made towards the entry into force of this amendment.
- 2. In response to further requests by the General Conference, the Director General submitted further reports on the progress made towards entry into force of this amendment to the 47<sup>th</sup>, 49<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, 51<sup>st</sup>, 53<sup>rd</sup> and 55<sup>th</sup> regular sessions of the General Conference (documents GC(47)/INF/5, GC(49)/3, GC(50)/7, GC(51)/7, GC(53)/10 and Mod.1, and GC(55)/9). At its 55<sup>th</sup> regular session, by decision GC(55)/DEC/12, the General Conference again "encourage[d] all Member States which ha[d] not done so to accept the amendment as soon as possible in accordance with their respective constitutional processes". The same decision took note of the report and requested the Director General to submit to the General Conference at its 57<sup>th</sup> regular session a report on the progress made towards the entry into force of this amendment.
- 3. The purpose of this document is to provide an updated report to Member States on the progress made.

#### **Progress Made towards Entry into Force**

- 4. In accordance with Article XVIII.C(ii) of the Statute, two-thirds of all Member States of the Agency (i.e. 106 States as of the date of this document) have to accept the amendment in order for it to enter into force. Since the report to the 55<sup>th</sup> regular session of the General Conference, the Agency has been informed by the depositary Government that four additional Member States have accepted the amendment. Consequently, the number of Member States that have accepted the amendment is fifty-five.
- 5. Attached as an Annex is a list of those States whose acceptance of this amendment has been notified by the depositary Government to the Agency as of the date of this document.
