

SUMMARY OF MEETINGS

held on Friday, 30 September 2022

**Plenary
10th
meeting**

Under **item 18** of the agenda, “Implementation of the NPT safeguards agreement between the Agency and the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea”, the Conference adopted the draft resolution contained in document GC(66)/L.3. Statements were made by China, the Russian Federation, Malaysia, the Republic of Korea, Japan and Australia.

Under **item 24** of the agenda, “Transfer of the nuclear materials in the context of AUKUS and its safeguards in all aspects under the NPT”, statements were made by China, Algeria, Australia (on behalf of Australia, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the United States of America), the Russian Federation, Malaysia, Brazil, Cuba, the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Belarus, South Africa, Egypt, Pakistan, Indonesia, Syrian Arab Republic, India, the Netherlands, Argentina, Norway, Japan, Canada, the Republic of Korea, Germany, Zimbabwe, France, Slovenia and the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Under **item 23** of the agenda, “Restoration of sovereign equality in the IAEA”, the Committee deferred submission of draft resolution GC(66)/COM.5/L.2.

The Committee agreed to recommend the following to the Conference for adoption:

- Under **item 10** of the agenda “The Agency’s Budget Update for 2023”, the draft resolutions contained in document GC(66)/6:
 - “A. Regular Budget Appropriations for 2023”, as amended;
 - “B. Technical Cooperation Fund Allocation for 2023”; and
 - “C. The Working Capital Fund for 2023”.
- Under **item 17** of the agenda, “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of Agency safeguards”, the draft resolution contained in document GC(66)/COM.5/L.14; and
- Under **item 13** of the agenda, “Nuclear and radiation safety”, the draft resolution contained in document GC(66)/COM.5/L.15.

The Committee continued consideration of **item 14** of the agenda, “Nuclear security”.

- under **item 13** of the agenda, “Nuclear and radiation safety”, the draft resolution contained in document GC(66)/L.10; and
- under **item 17** of the agenda, “Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency of Agency safeguards”, the draft resolution contained in document GC(66)/L.9.; statements were made by China, Israel, India, Australia (on behalf of Australia, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the United States of America), Pakistan and the Russian Federation.

Under **item 21** of the agenda, “Promotion of Efficiency and Effectiveness of the IAEA Decision Making Process” and under **item 23** of the agenda, “Restoration of sovereign equality in the IAEA”, the Conference took note of the report of the Chair of the Committee of the Whole. Under item 23, statements were made by Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan, Russian Federation, Pakistan and Türkiye.

Under **item 14** of the agenda, “Nuclear security”, the Conference approved by a vote the draft resolution contained in documents GC(66)/COM.5/L.17/Rev.1 and GC(66)/COM.5/L.17/Rev.1/Corr.1.

Under **item 26** of the agenda, “Report on contributions pledged to the Technical Cooperation Fund for 2023” contained in document GC(66)/15, the President gave a statement.

The President expressed his gratitude for the cooperation and the assistance extended to him and for the valuable support, which enabled the successful completion of the work of the Conference.
