Soehartati Gondhowiardjo, M.D., Ph.D. is a radiation oncologist and senior consultant in the Department of Radiotherapy at Cipto Mangunkusumo National General Hospital (RSCM) Jakarta. Currently, she is the Chairperson of the National Cancer Control Committee (NCCC), the President of the Federation of Asian Organizations for Radiation Oncology (FARO), and President of the Indonesian Radiation Oncology Society (IROS). She earned her medical degree in 1980, received her certification as a radiologist in 1987 and studied Radiation

Oncology at the Strahlentherapie Abteilung Wilhelm-Waestfaelichen, Universitaet Muenster, Germany in 1988. Her research activities include several topics in radiation oncology physics and molecular oncology. Her current fields of interest include breast cancer, stereotactic, CNS tumours, and head and neck cancers. Her past positions include President of the South East Asian Radiation Oncology Group (SEAROG), the Indonesian Society for Oncology (ISO), and Council Member of the Asian Clinical Oncology Society (ACOS), among others. In addition to organizational, clinical, and research work, she is also responsible as the National Project Coordinator for several IAEA projects, including Transition from 2D to 3D to Intensity Modulated Radiotherapy (IMRT), Stereotactic Body Radiotherapy (SBRT) and Quality Assurance in Radiotherapy (QUATRO).
