COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED FROM CERTAIN MEMBER STATES REGARDING
GUIDELINES FOR THE EXPORT OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL,
EQUIPMENT OR TECHNOLOGY

A further communication, dated 6 August 1987

1. On 6 August 1987 the Director General received a letter dated 6 August 1987 from the Permanent Mission of Switzerland to the International Organizations in Vienna relating to the export of nuclear material, equipment or technology.
2. As requested, the text of the letter is reproduced below for the information of all Member States.

“The Permanent Mission of Switzerland presents its compliments to the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency and, with reference to the Mission’s letter No. 004 of 11 January 1978, reproduced under the heading “Letter XI” in document INFCIRC/254 of February 1978, has the honour to state that, consequent upon revision of national legislation, the principles governing transfer of technology set forth in the documents appended to the Mission’s letter No. 003 of 11 January 1978 have been fully applied in Switzerland since 1 April 1987.

The Permanent Mission would be grateful to the Director General if he could communicate the text of this letter to the Governments of all States Members of the IAEA.

The Permanent Mission of Switzerland takes this opportunity to reiterate to the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency the assurances of its highest esteem.
