COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED FROM CERTAIN MEMBER STATES REGARDING GUIDELINES FOR THE EXPORT OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT AND TECHNOLOGY

A further communication, dated 28 November 1989

- 1. On 8 December 1989 the Director General received a Note Verbale dated 28 November 1989 from the Permanent Mission of Luxembourg relating to the export of nuclear material, equipment or technology.
- As requested, the text of the Note Verbale is reproduced below for the information of all Member States.

The Permanent Mission of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg to the International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency, and, with reference to the communications set out in document INFCIRC/254/Add.5, has the honour to inform the Director General that the Luxembourg Government is now in a position to implement fully the principles for technology transfer which are set out in the documents figuring in the Appendix to document INFCIRC/254.

The relevant regulations of the Grand Duchy on transfers of nuclear material, equipment and technology and on the physical protection thereof, dated 31 July 1989, entered into force on 1 September 1989.
