The Permanent Mission of Ukraine to the International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honour to communicate the following.

The Russian occupants continue to systematically commit criminal acts and terrorize the Zaporizhzhia NPP personnel as well as local civilian population.

In the last few weeks, the Russian occupants have been regularly shelling the territory of the Zaporizhzhia NPP and Enerhodar city.

On August 14, 2022, the Russian army fired six shells at occupied Enerhodar, as a result of which one person died and two others were injured.

One employee of the Zaporizhzhia NPP, shop foreman Mr Maksym Marko, died on the spot. Other wounded employees were taken to the specialized medical and sanitary unit of Enerhodar

The Permanent Mission of Ukraine requests the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency to promptly circulate this Note Verbale as Information Circular to all IAEA Member States.
