Svetlana Saakyan is the Head of the Department of Ophthalmooncology and Radiology at the Moscow Helmholtz Research Institute of Eye Diseases. She is currently a Professor at Moscow State University in the Department of Eye Diseases as well as an Honoured Doctor of the Russian Federation.

Dr. Saakyan received her Ph.D. after writing her doctoral thesis on the prevention and treatment of retinoblastoma in 2002. Her clinical research specializes in intraocular tumours, orbital tumours, eyelid and conjunctiva tumours as well as surgery and brachytherapy in ocular oncology. Dr. Saakyan has co-authored the Russian National Manual on Ophthalmology as well as the AJCC Cancer Staging Manual, 8th Edition. Additionally, Dr. Saakyan is a Member of the Presidium Board of the Russian Society of Ophthalmologists as well as a Member of the Euretina, ESTRO, ISOO, and OOG and on the Expert Panel for the American Joint Committee on Cancer.
