Pierre Scalliet is the Head of Radiotherapy at Clinique Universitaires Saint Luc as well as a full Professor of Clinical Oncology and the Associate Director of the Cancer Centre. He obtained his Ph.D. from the Université Catholique de Louvain while specializing in Internal Medicine and Radiation Oncology. He has participated in various scientific societies, including the Belgian Society for Psychosocial Oncology (present), the Independent Data Monitoring Committee of the EORTC (present), ESTRO, the Société Belge de Radiothérapie-Oncologie, and the International Society of Radiation Oncology. He has collaborated with many respected scientific journals both as a Clinical Editor and Associate Editor. He is currently serving as an expert to the Division of Human Health at the IAEA and has been active in this role since 1995. Dr. Scalliet has received a number of awards for his achievements in radiotherapy and oncology, such as the Emmanuel Van der Schueren Award, the Marie Sklodowska Curie medal of the Polish Society of Radiotherapy, and the Jean Roy memorial lecture from the Canadian Brachytherapy Group.
