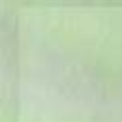

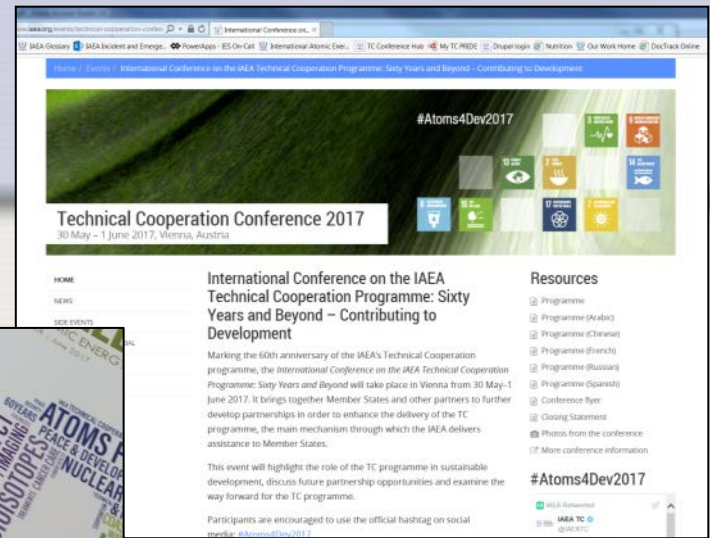

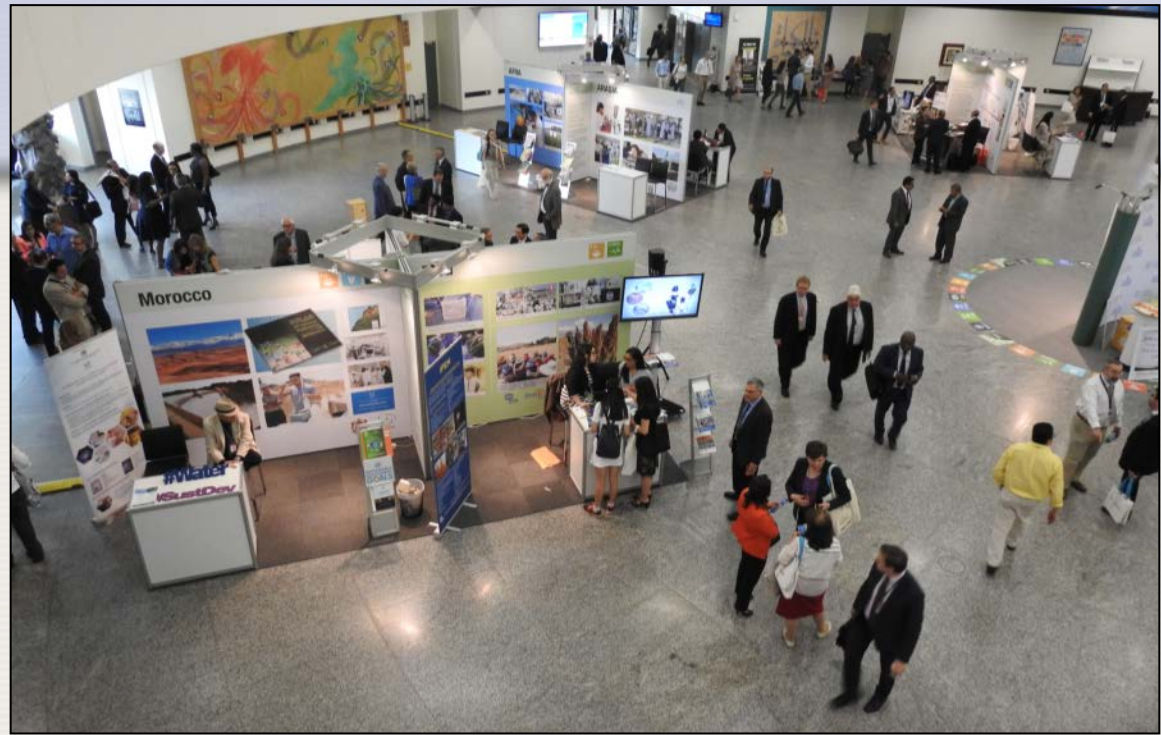


Closing session

- TC programme has successfully built nuclear capacity in Member States over the past six decades, resulting in sustainable developmental impact
